Core of an Iron Golem

In Game Description

Soul serving as the core of the Iron Golem, guardian of Sen's Fortress, and slayer of countless heroes seeking Anor Londo.

Originally a bone of an everlasting dragon.

Use to acquire a huge amount of souls, or to create a unique weapon.

Availability

Defeat the Iron Golem

Use

- Provides 12,000 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for only **8,000** souls
- With a +10 Hand Axe or a +10 Battle Axe, craft the Golem Axe
- With a +10 Caestus or a +10 Claw, craft the Dragon Bone Fist

Fire Keeper Soul

In Game Description

Fire Keeper Soul (Generic)

Soul of a long-lost Fire Keeper.

Each Fire Keeper is a corporeal manifestation of her bonfire, and a draw for the humanity which is offered to her. Her soul is gnawed by infinite humanity, and can boost the power of precious Estus Flasks. Reinforced Estus Flasks capture denser Estus, allowing for increased restoration of HP.

Fire Keeper Soul (Anastacia of Astora)

*Soul of the Ash Maiden,
Fire Keeper of Firelink Shrine.*

*A Fire Keeper's soul is a draw for humanity, and held within their bosoms, below just a thin layer of skin, are swarms of humanity that writhe and squirm.
Was the Ash Maiden locked in this dark prison for some transgression, or by her own will?*

Fire Keeper Soul (Lady of the Darkling)

*Soul of the Darkmoon Knightess,
Fire Keeper of Anor Londo.*

A Fire Keeper's soul is a draw for humanity, and held within their bosoms, below just a thin layer of skin, are swarms of humanity that writhe and squirm. Her brass armor serves to disguise this ghastly form.

Fire Keeper Soul (Quelaag's Sister)

*Soul of a Daughter of Chaos,
Fire Keeper of Quelaag's Domain.*

*A Fire Keeper's soul is a draw for humanity,
and held within their bosoms, below just a
thin layer of skin, are swarms of humanity
that writhe and squirm.
To her, the countless eggs which appeared
were cradles for each tiny humanity.*

Availability

- Dropped by Lady of the Darkling (her Fire Keeper Soul)
- Dropped by Quelaag's Sister (her Fire Keeper Soul)
- Dropped by Knight Lautrec of Carim after you invade his world with Black Eye Orb and kill him in Anor Londo (Anastacia of Astora's Fire Keeper Soul)
- Treasure from a corpse on the altar in Undead Parish, near the shortcut to Firelink Shrine, guarded by a non-respawning Heavy Knight
- Treasure from a corpse in upper New Londo Ruins. From the Firelink Shrine elevator, go left until you reach the wooden bridge. Cross the bridge until you are in the area with the Ghosts. Walk on the right side of the area but be careful not to fall off. If you have drained the ruins of water, there will be a narrow pathway leading to a small, broken down structure with the corpse in plain sight. Proceed to the Fire Keeper Soul, but be careful of the three Ghosts that will spawn when near the structure.
- Treasure from a corpse inside a cell in Blighttown. From the swamp elevator, get on the elevator, then get off at the highest point. Climb the short ladder. After the Cragspider, go forward to the stone-walled area with the Blowdart Snipers. Cross the wooden bridge (you can see the cell while you're on the bridge, look left and below), you'll see a ladder to the lower stone-walled area. This lower area is occupied with Flaming Attack Dogs. Go forward a bit, then turn right to see the cell with the corpse, guarded by two Flaming Attack Dogs.
- Treasure from a corpse in The Duke's Archives' prison tower's giant cell. It's in the same cell where Big Hat Logan is held captive; the cell guarded by Pisacas. You need the Archive Tower Giant Cell Key to open the cell door.

Use

-
- Grants 5 Humanity (stat) if consumed.
 - Fully restores HP.
 - Trade to any Fire Keeper (Anastacia of Astora, Quelaag's Sister, or Lady of the Darkling) to upgrade your Estus Flask, to a maximum of Estus Flask +7. Use "Reinforce Estus Flask" in their dialogue option.
 - Feed to Kingseeker Frampt for 1,000 souls.

Notes

- You cannot carry more than 7 unique Fire Keeper Souls (One from each location/drop). If you attempt to pick one you already possess in your inventory, your character will simply leave the item on the ground.
- It's not advisable to consume the Fire Keeper Soul until after your Estus Flask is at +7 (maximum level), or at least at the level where it can fully heal you with a single charge (i.e. when you have low max HP)
- It's also not advisable to consume Anastacia of Astora's Fire Keeper Soul if you still want to use Firelink Shrine's bonfire

Guardian Soul

In Game Description

Soul of the white winged lion sanctuary watchkeeper, who dreaded the spread of the Abyss.

The Guardian exhibited traits of several animals other than lions, suggesting that it was no ordinary beast, but rather closer to the beings known as Demons.

Availability

Drops from the Sanctuary Guardian

Use

- Can be consumed for 12,000 souls
- Feed to Kingseeker Frampt for only 10,000 souls

Large Soul of a Brave Warrior

In Game Description

Large soul of a brave Undead warrior who has long ago gone Hollow.

Use to acquire a large amount of souls.

Souls are the source of all life, and whether Undead, or even Hollow, one continues to seek them.

Use

Provides 8,000 souls when consumed

Availability

- Darkroot Garden x1
 - In the forest area, behind the clearing containing the three Great Felines
- Sen's Fortress x1
 - On the rooftop near the bonfire
- Lost Izalith x1
 - In a nook behind the base of the staircase containing the Chaos Eater, near the tunnel with the many Demonic Statues
- The Duke's Archives x1
 - In the prison tower, in the locked cell requiring the Archive Prison Extra Key

Large Soul of a Lost Undead

In Game Description

*Large soul of a lost Undead
who has long ago gone Hollow.*

Use to acquire souls.

*Souls are the source of all life,
and whether Undead, or even Hollow,
one continues to seek them.*

Use

- Provides 400 souls when consumed
- Provides 500 souls when fed to Kingseeker Frampt

Availability

- Firelink Shrine x2
 - Located in the Graveyard area
- Upper Undead Burg x2
 - On the platform below the first outdoor, breakable barrels
 - Hidden behind breakable boxes after the Taurus Demon
- Lower Undead Burg x2
 - Located in a barrel near the Capra Demon
 - Near the Depths entrance
- Undead Parish x1
 - On the wooden beam near the Mystery Key
- Blighttown
 - Drop from the Infested Ghouls (10% drop rate)

Large Soul of a Nameless Soldier

In Game Description

Large soul of a nameless Undead soldier who has long ago gone Hollow.

Use to acquire many souls.

Souls are the source of all life, and whether Undead, or even Hollow, one continues to seek them.

Use

Provides 1,000 souls when consumed

Availability

- Undead Parish x1
 - On the corpse draped over the window in the upstairs area of the church
- Depths x2
 - By the first hollow enemy in the level, near the entrance staircase
 - In the Basilisk area
- Blighttown x2
 - By the breakable wooden floor in upper-Blighttown
 - On the wooden structure near the Parasitic Wall Hugger
- Valley of Drakes x1
 - Outside the New Londo Ruins entrance
- Darkroot Garden x3

- In the basin, by the Crystal Golems
- Behind a cliff-side rock on the path the bonfire
- In the nook containing the trap Demonic Foliage that attack you when you pick up the item
- Catacombs x3
 - In the area containing the first Necromancer
 - On the piece of land with Paladin Leeroy's soul sign. Drop down from the ledge near the entrance to the hallway leading to the Prowling Demon
 - By the top of the ladder adjacent to the hallway containing the Prowling Demon
- The Great Hollow x2
 - Outside the "room" containing the three Basilisks
 - At the top of the branch path leading into the lower mushroom area

 - On a ledge near the top of shortcut ladder

Large Soul of a Proud Knight

In-Game Description

Large soul of a proud Undead knight who has long ago gone Hollow.

Use to acquire many souls.

Souls are the source of all life, and whether Undead, or even Hollow, one continues to seek them.

Use

Provides 3,000 souls when consumed

Availability

- Blighttown x3
 - In the poison lake, underneath the wooden structure leading to upper-blighttown
 - In the poison lake, near a lone-Giant Leech
 - In the poison lake, behind a pillar near Maneater Mildred's spawn location
- Sen's Fortress x2
 - By the top of the ladder exiting the tar pit
 - By the Serpent Mage overlooking the indoors boulder-path
- Demon Ruins x1
 - In the lava drained area, on a rock surrounded by lava
- Tomb of the Giants x6
 - Behind the Giant Skeleton to the right after descending the first slide-ramp
 - x2 in the Patches pit, by the Skull Lantern
 - x2 after climbing the tall ladder protected by the Giant Skeleton and Giant Skeleton Archer. One on nearby ledge, other on drop-down ledge
 - On the ledge of the path returning to the Pinwheel/ Catacombs area

- New Londo Ruins x4
 - In the water drained area, by the Darkwraith near the pool of shallow water
 - In the water drained area, on the staircase leading into the bottom floor of the building with Ingward on the roof
 - In the water drained area, on a landing around to the side of the building with Ingward on the roof

Use to acquire a large amount of souls.

*Souls are the source of all life,
and whether Undead, or even Hollow,
one continues to seek them.*

Use

Provides 5,000 souls when consumed

Availability

- Darkroot Garden x1
 - In the forest area, in the valley between the two long ladders leading to the basin
- Sen's Fortress x2
 - In the first room with the two Serpent Soldiers and arrow trap
 - In the tar pit by the second Titanite Demon protecting the Scythe
- Demon Ruins x4
 - By the lone Minor Capra Demon that is located near the Demon Firesage boss area
 - In the corridor to the Lost Izalith shortcut, located on a ledge to the side of the branch walkway
 - In the area after the Demon Firesage encounter, behind three Demonic Statues
 - In the room with the bonfire before the Centipede Demon, on a ledge to the side of the branch walkway
- Lost Izalith x3
 - In the lava area with the Bounding Demons, at the end of the first branch path entering the area

- In the lava area with the Bounding Demons, on a patch of land near the central structure
- In the poison pit.
- The Duke's Archives x2
 - Underneath the staircase in the first grand hall
 - In the prison tower, on the drop-down path through the locked door in the bonfire room

Use

- Provides 20,000 souls when consumed
- Provides 1000 souls when fed to Kingseeker Frampt

Availability

- Treasure from a corpse in the area where you encounter Seath the Scaleless for the first time. It's on the circular balcony above the main floor. It becomes available only after Seath has moved to the official boss room in the Crystal Cave.
- Treasure from a chest in the first tower of the magma lake in Lost Izalith, as you head towards the area boss.

Soul of a Hero

In Game Description

*Soul of a hero of legend
who has long ago gone Hollow.*

Use to acquire a large amount of souls.

*Souls are the source of all life,
and whether Undead, or even Hollow,
one continues to seek them.*

Use

Provides 10,000 souls when consumed

Availability

- Found on a corpse in a cage next to Big Hat Logan in Sen's Fortress
- Found on a corpse on the end of a walkway in Anor Londo, where the left-hand Silver Knight archer is
- Found on the balcony above the Titanite Demon in Anor Londo
- Found on a corpse in the chamber where the Skeleton Baby spawn in Tomb of the Giants (x2)
- Found on a corpse past the drop invisible bridge in Crystal Cave
- Found on a corpse above the tunnel in Lost Izalith, past the magma lake through the regular entrance
- Found on some in the abyss infected part of Oolacile Township
- Found in the room before battling Manus, Father of the Abyss
- Found on a corpse in the ravine where Black Dragon, Kalameet appears

Soul of a Lost Undead

In Game Description

Soul of a lost Undead who has long ago gone Hollow.

Use to acquire souls.

Souls are the source of all life, and whether Undead, or even Hollow, one continues to seek them.

Use

- Provides 200 souls when consumed
- Provides 500 souls when fed to Kingseeker Frampt

Availability

- Undead Asylum x1
 - Located on the cliff opposite of Snuggly's trading nest.
- Firelink Shrine x6
 - At the top of the stairs by the elevator to the Undead Parish.
 - Hugging a cliffside-wall to the left of the watery area.
 - On the walkway above the watery area, near the giant crow.
 - x3 near and inside the aqueduct tunnel.
- Upper Undead Burg x3
 - In the room after the first fog gate.
 - In the building below the first, outdoor breakable barrels.
 - On the platform with the three firebomb-throwing hollows.
- Blighttown
 - Drop from the Infested Ghouls (20% drop rate)

Soul of a Nameless Soldier

In Game Description

*Soul of a nameless Undead soldier
who has long ago gone Hollow.*

Use to acquire souls.

*Souls are the source of all life,
and whether Undead, or even Hollow,
one continues to seek them.*

Use

- Provides 800 souls when consumed

Availability

- Upper Undead Burg x1
 - On the Hellkite Dragon bridge
- Depths x5
 - In the Giant Rat room
 - In a corridor near the Giant Undead Rat
 - Underneath the lone-slime trap
 - In the corridor before the fog gate by the Channeler
 - In the Basilisk area
- New Londo Ruins
 - In a nook near the bottom of the Firelink Shrine elevator
- Blighttown
 - Drop from the Infested Ghouls (5% drop rate)

Soul of a Proud Knight

In Game Description

Soul of a proud Undead knight who has long ago gone Hollow.

Use to acquire many souls.

Souls are the source of all life, and whether Undead, or even Hollow, one continues to seek them.

Use

Provides 2,000 souls when consumed

Availability

- Blighttown x5
 - At the end of the lower-platform to the right of the Infested Barbarians, traveling from the Depths entrance
 - x2 on the wooden structures near the upper bonfire
 - On the wooden structure overlooking the Parasitic Wall Hugger
 - In the area with the several Blowdart Snipers
- Valley of Drakes x1
 - By the Undead Dragon
- Darkroot Garden x1
 - By the multiple Frog-Rays
- Catacombs x5
 - In a dead end shortly after the first rotating bridge lever
 - x2 in the 'main shaft' area behind the second Necromancer
 - In the Black Knight room, overlooking the Skeleton Wheel area

- At the end of the return path towards the Skeleton Wheel area, from the Tomb of the Giants entrance
- Demon Ruins x3
 - Near the first Minor Capra Demon in the lava-drained area
 - By the bonfire underneath the Capra Demons
 - Before the descending staircase containing the first Demonic Statues, to the right
- New Londo Ruins x1
 - At the dead end of a hallway inside the building with Ingward on the roof

Soul of Artorias

In-Game Description

*Soul of Lord Gwyn's Knight Artorias,
who was consumed by the Abyss.*

*The legend that Artorias repelled the Abyss
only told half the story.*

*It seems that he was defeated, and his
honor preserved, by some unsung hero,
who is the true victor of the Abyss.*

Availability

100% drop by Knight Artorias

Use

- With a +10 Dagger-class weapon, Straight sword, or Greatsword-class weapon, craft the Abyss Greatsword
- Trade with Lord's Blade Ciaran for the Dark Silver Tracer and Gold Tracer
- Can be consumed for 16,000 souls, or fed to Kingseeker Frampt for only 10,000 souls

Soul of Gwyn, Lord of Cinder

In Game Description

Soul of Gwyn, the Lord of Sunlight and Cinder, who linked the First Flame.

Lord Gwyn bequeathed most of his power to the Gods, and burned as cinder for the First Flame, but even so, Lord Gwyn's soul is a powerful thing indeed.

Availability

Defeat Gwyn, Lord of Cinder.

Use

- Provides 20,000 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for 40,000 souls.
- With a +10 Straight Sword, Dagger or Greatsword, craft the Great Lord Greatsword.
- As a +1 rank member of the Warrior of Sunlight Covenant, offer it at the Altar of Sunlight to acquire the Sunlight Spear miracle.

Soul of Gwyndolin

In Game Description

Soul of Darkmoon Gwyndolin, god of the Dark Sun and guardian of deserted Anor Londo.

Special beings have special souls.

Use the soul of Gwyn's lastborn to acquire a huge amount of souls, or to create a unique weapon.

Availability

Defeat Dark Sun Gwyndolin

Use

- Provides 16,000 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for 20,000 souls
- With a +10 bow, craft the Darkmoon Bow
- With a catalyst¹, craft the Tin Darkmoon Catalyst

Footnotes 1. Izalith Catalyst and Demon's Catalyst cannot be used.

Soul of Manus

In Game Description

*Soul of Manus, Father of the Abyss.
This extraordinary soul is a viscous,
lukewarm lump of gentle humanity.*

*Ancient Manus was clearly once human.
But he became the Father of the Abyss
after his humanity went wild, eternally
seeking his precious broken pendant.*

Availability

Manus, Father of the Abyss drop

Use

- Consume for 18,000 souls
- Give to Frampt for 10,000 souls
- Can be combined with any catalyst to create the Manus Catalyst
- Can be traded with Snuggly the Crow for Pursuers, an Abyss version of Homing Soulmass

Soul of Ornstein

In Game Description

Soul of Ornstein, Dragonslayer Knight who guards the cathedral in the forsaken city of Anor Londo.

Special beings have special souls. Lord Gwyn granted this soul to his four most trusted knights.

Use to acquire a large amount of souls, or to create a unique weapon.

Availability

Must defeat Executioner Smough **first** when fighting Dragon Slayer Ornstein & Executioner Smough

Use

- Provides 12,000 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for only 8,000 souls
- With a +10 spear or thrusting sword, craft the Dragonslayer Spear

Soul of Priscilla

In Game Description

*Soul of Priscilla the Crossbreed,
trapped inside the painted world of Ariamis.*

*Special beings have special souls.
Use the soul of this crossbreed bastard
child and antithesis to all life to acquire
a huge amount (sic) of souls, or to create
a unique weapon.*

Availability

Defeat Crossbreed Priscilla

Use

- Provides 12,000 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for 15,000 souls
- With a +10 scythe, great scythe, halberd, or whip, craft the Lifehunt Scythe

Soul of Quelaag

In Game Description

Soul of Quelaag, once daughter of the Witch of Izalith, but now a chaos demon.

*Special beings have special souls, and Quelaag's soul contains all aspects of Chaos.
Use it to acquire a huge amount of souls, or to create a unique weapon.*

Availability

Defeat the Chaos Witch Quelaag

Use

- Provides 8,000 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for 10,000 souls
- With a +10 Katana (Uchigatana, Iaito, Washing Pole), craft the Chaos Blade
- With a +10 curved sword (Falchion, Scimitar, etc.), craft the Quelaag's Furysword

Soul of Sif

In-Game Description

Soul of Sif the Great Grey Wolf, who guards the grave of Artorias the Abysswalker.

Special beings have special souls.

Use the soul of Sif, who inherited the divine knightsword, to acquire a huge amount of souls, or to create a unique weapon.

Availability

100% drop by Sif, the Great Grey Wolf

Use

- Provides 16,000 souls when consumed.
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for only **4,000** souls
- With a +10 Broken Straight Sword or +10 Straight Sword Hilt, craft the Greatsword of Artorias
- With a +10 Dagger¹, Greatsword², or any other Straight sword, craft the Greatsword of Artorias (Cursed).
- With a +10 Shield, craft the Greatshield of Artorias

Notes

- For new players, it's generally recommended to make the Greatshield of Artorias first, if any. While the Greatshield does require a high investment of 34 Strength to be used, either Greatsword requires even more difficult investments in all four of Strength, Dexterity, Intelligence, and Faith, and are much more niche in use compared to the well-rounded Greatshield.

Footnotes 1. The Dagger weapon class. 2. The Greatsword weapon class, **not** the Greatsword

weapon which is of the Ultra Greatsword weapon class. Although the Greatsword weapon can still be used.

Soul of Smough

In Game Description

Soul of Smough the Executioner, who guards the cathedral in the forsaken city of Anor Londo.

Special beings have special souls.

Use the soul of this eerily gleeful executioner to acquire a huge amount of souls, or to create a unique weapon.

Availability

Must defeat the Dragon Slayer Ornstein **first** when fighting Dragon Slayer Ornstein & Executioner Smough

Use

- Provides 12,000 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for **1** soul
- With a +10 blunt weapon (Club, Mace, Morning Star, etc), craft the Smough's Hammer

Soul of the Moonlight Butterfly

In-Game Description

*Soul of the mystical Moonlight Butterfly,
which flitters in the Darkroot Garden.*

*Special beings have special souls.
The butterfly's soul is a creation of
Seath the Scaleless.*

*Use to acquire a huge amount of souls,
or to create a unique weapon.*

Availability

100% drop by the Moonlight Butterfly boss in Darkroot Garden.

Use

- Provides 1,200 souls when consumed
- Feed Kingseeker Frampt for 8,000 souls
- With a +10 Shield, craft the Crystal Ring Shield
- With a +10 Spear¹, craft the Moonlight Butterfly Horn

Footnotes 1. The Spear weapon class.

Souls

- Souls can be obtained in 'loose form' by killing enemies. These are added to the current total in the bottom right of the HUD.
- The number of Souls an enemy drops in loose form depends on the current playthrough and to some extent the Damage inflicted.
- Souls in 'solid form' can be collected as treasure or by killing Bosses.
- Refer to the Soul Farming page for guidance on accumulating souls faster.
